Major:	Prerequisites:
Social Ecology (general)	Minimum overall UC GPA of 2.0. Completion of two lower-division Social Ecology core courses (Crm/Law C7, Environ E8, PsyBeh P9/Psych 7A, SocEcol 10, SocEcol 13) with a grade of "C" or better in each.
Psychology & Social Behavior	Minimum overall UC GPA of 2.0. Completion of PsyBeh P11A,B,C/Psych 9A,B,C with an average 2.8 GPA in the 3 courses.
Criminology, Law & Society	Minimum overall UC GPA of 2.3. Completion of Crm/Law C7 and one additional lower-division Social Ecology core course (Environ E8, PsyBeh P9/Psych 7A, SocEcol 10, SocEcol 13) with a grade of "C" or better in each.
Public Health Policy (B.A.)	Minimum overall UC GPA of 2.0. Completion of PubHlth 1 (formerly Environ E7) and PubHlth 2 (formerly Environ E9) with a grade of "C" or better in each.
Public Health Science (B.S.)	Minimum overall UC GPA of 2.0. Completion of PubHlth 1 and/or PubHlth 2 with no grade below "C". Completion of Chem 1A and one additional lower-division mathematics or science course required for the major with a minimum GPA of 2.0 (selected from Chem 1B, 1C, 51B, 51C; BioSci 93, 94, 97, 98, 99; Math 2A, 2B; Math 7 or BioSci 7). An average GPA of 2.0 in any additional required courses completed for the major. <i>**Students planning to change majors to Public Health Science (B.S.) are strongly encouraged to begin course work to meet the science and math requirements.</i>

TO CHANGE, DECLARE OR ADD A DOUBLE MAJOR, FOLLOW THE INSTRUCTIONS BELOW:

All prerequisite requirements must be completed before applying. Requirements include:

- Entry Level Writing
- Required courses established by the specific department (see table above)

Submit an Undergraduate Petition for Change of Major form—the **paper form** is available at the Registrar's Office, Social Ecology Student Services or your undergraduate counseling office.

For students who have completed 120 units or more or wishing to declare a double or triple major:
